**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 77 OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF EMERSON ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Emerson has established a Police Department pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-188, Chapter 77 of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough discovered that contradictory language was inadvertently left in after a prior modification was made to the code by Ordinance No. 1380-09, to Chapter 77, and;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Emerson that § 77-8 G. Promotional standards for promotion to rank of Lieutenant is hereby amended as follows:

Section I. The Code of the Borough of Emerson, § 77-8. G entitled **Promotional standards for promotion to rank of Lieutenant** is hereby amended by deleting the first sentence after the heading which reads: *'The Borough of Emerson requires that the Lieutenant have a minimum of three years experience as a PTC certified Emerson police officer, and have held the rank of Sergeant with the Borough of Emerson Police Department.'* so that it does not conflict with # 3 of the same section.

Section III: All other parts of § 77-8 G. of the Code of the Borough of Emerson shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction declares any part of this Ordinance unenforceable, it is the intent that the remainder of the Ordinance remain in full force and effect.

Section V: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
