NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was adopted on the second reading after a Public Hearing at the Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson on the 18th day of February, 2014. AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1373-09 CHAPTER ONE ENTITLED ADMINISTRATIVE LEGISLATION ARTICLE II § 1-15 SCHEDULE OF MINIMUM FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF EMERSON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Emerson as follows:

Section 1: The "Schedule of Minimum Fines" for violations of various sections of the Code of The Borough of Emerson is amended to include fines for parking illegally in reserved commuter parking spaces without a paid parking tag or transferring the paid commuter parking tag to another motor vehicle not included under the name and address of the holder of the reserved commuter parking tag without having to appear in court as follows:

Section 2: Severability and Effectiveness Clause:

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- (b) Any ordinance inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
