THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EMERSON BOARD OF HEALTH WAS HELD ON JUNE 11, 2015 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE BOROUGH HALL.

These Minutes have not been formally approved by the Emerson Board of Health and are subject to change or modification at the next regular meeting at which time they will be adopted.

Roll Call: Elaine Rizzo, Nicole Argenzia, Cindy Bischoff, and Linda Lahey. Also present was Daniel Levy, Health Officer; K. A. Hodges, Public Health Nurse; Board of Health liaison Danielle Di Paola and Peggy Di Lello, Health Assistant

Absentee: Gabriel Whited

Health Assistant notified the Board of Health members that in case of a fire follow the Fire Exit sign above the door to the left of the Conference Room and exit calmly.

The June 11, 2015 Board of Health meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Board of Health President Elaine Rizzo.

Motion by Nicole Argenzia, Seconded by Cindy Bischoff, that the Board of Health Minutes of May 14, 2015 be approved with the following amendments:

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Tattoo Parlor Ordinance

The Borough Attorney, Borough Administrator and Board of Health members reviewed the draft Tattoo Parlor Ordinance and made revisions.

b. Cloud Nine Vapes

The establishment is operating without a written C/O, and it is unclear whether the Building Department or Land Use Board issued a "verbal" C/O.

The Financial, Vital Statistics, and Dog Licensing reports for May were accepted as submitted.

The Health Inspector's report for May was accepted as submitted.

Health Officer Daniel Levy reported that Laurel Chinese was inspected and received a Conditional rating because of poor housekeeping.

The Health Officer's report for May was accepted as submitted.

Ben Thorp asked for an update on the Tattoo and Body Piercing Establishment ordinance. Health Officer Daniel Levy replied that the Board of Health members are working on the ordinance and a draft should be completed by September.

Health Officer Daniel Levy received a report from the NJ DEP that ground water was found in an off-site monitoring well at 200 Kinderkamack Road, which is a former gas station.

The Board of Health members discussed whether there should be a fence around food establishment dumpsters. Health Officer Daniel Levy responded that since it is not in the Sanitary Code, the Board of Health could adopt a local ordinance.

Health Officer Daniel Levy noted that Casa Maselli will be selling Italian Ices at the town picnic on June 20. The Board of Health members agreed that a special event permit be issued to Casa Maselli at a fee of \$100.00.

Casa Maselli will be selling food at Assumption Church carnival and will require a special permit at a fee of \$100.00 for the event.

Health Officer noted that Hackensack Golf Club's new pool and snack bar will be opening soon.

The Public Health Nurse's report for May was accepted as submitted.

Payment of Vouchers:

Council liaison Verbal Report:

Danielle Di Paola noted that the Recreation Commission encourages someone from each Board to attend the town picnic and hand out information about their specific committee.

Danielle Di Paola reported that the Construction Official issued Cloud Nine Vapes a temporary paper Certificate of Occupancy with the following conditions:

1. No one under the age of 19 years old is permitted to enter the store.
2. Several signs must be posted inside the store indicating the age requirements.
3. Provide several signs indicating that no smoking and no vaping is permitted inside the store.
4. No tables, chairs or couches are permitted or any lounging inside the store.
5. All Borough of Emerson Codes must be followed or the Certificate of Occupancy will be revoked.

Question was posed by the Board of Health members as to whether an electronic cigarette is included in the 'Definitions' of the "Ordinance Prohibiting Smoking Upon Parks,

Playgrounds and Recreational Areas” in Emerson. Health Officer Daniel Levy will discuss the matter with the Borough Administrator.

Board of Health President Elaine Rizzo distributed literature on the health risks of E-cigarettes, smokeless tobacco and water pipes.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Tattoo Parlor Ordinance

The Board of Health members reviewed the Tattoo Parlor Ordinance before it is submitted to the Borough Attorney for approval.

b. Cloud Nine Vapes

Health Officer Daniel Levy reported that the meeting with the Borough Administrator and Construction Official went well. The health department would resolve an issue with Cloud Nine Vapes if there was a complaint.

During the meeting, Daniel Levy suggested that the Construction Official notify the health department if there is an establishment that impacts the health and welfare of residents.

Health Officer Daniel Levy suggested that there should be a written approval process form for new establishments to be signed off by applicable departments.

NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Board of Health President Elaine Rizzo read a card from K. A. Hodges thanking the members for celebrating her forty-eight (48) years as Emerson’s Public Health Nurse and honoring her with a nurse’s pendant.

Having no business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:52 p.m.
