Presiding Officer Dave Rector notified the Recreation Commission members that in case of a fire follow the Fire Exit signs above the doors and exit calmly.

The meeting of the Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:39 p.m. with a quorum in attendance.

I Open Session.

Presiding Officer Dave Rector notified the Recreation Commission members that no one will be in attendance for Open Session.

II Fireworks

Presiding Officer Dave Rector submitted the fireworks management plan for the Recreation Commission's perusal. The Board of Education facilities coordinator has approved the June 15 event.
