NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was adopted on the second reading after a Public Hearing at the Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson on the 3rd day of April, 2018. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 274 OF THE CODE OF EMERSON ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ARTICLE VII, SCHEDULE XX§ 274-56 TITLED SCHEDULE XX: BUS STOPS

Be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Emerson, in accordance with the provisions of § 274-27, the following described locations are hereby designated as bus stops. No other vehicle other than an omnibus, picking up or discharging passengers, shall be permitted to occupy said location between the hours indicated.

Section I. §56 of Chapter 274, Schedule XX: Bus Stops. is hereby amended to delete d. Highland Avenue and e. Seneca Avenue. under 3. Kinderkamack Road Northbound and replace it with the following:

Name of Street	Hours
Kinderkamack Road, Northbound on the easterly side at:	All
c. Louis Street and Demarest Avenue – (midblock) Beginning at the point 176 feet north of the northerly curblines of Louis Street	
d. Seneca Avenue and Green Street – (midblock) Beginning at the point 264 feet north of the northerly curblines of Seneca Avenue	

Section II. §56 of Chapter 274, Schedule XX: Bus Stops. is hereby amended to delete e. Demarest Avenue under 4. Kinderkamack Road Southbound on the westerly side and replace it with as follows:

Name of Street	Hours
Kinderkamack Road, Southbound on the westerly side at:	All
e. Allison Way and Demarest Avenue – (midblock) Beginning at the point 140 feet north of the northerly curblines of Allison Way	


Section III. Severability and Repealer.


