NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was adopted on the second reading after a Public Hearing at the Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson on the 18th day of December, 2018. AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF EMERSON CHAPTER 77 THEREOF, TITLED POLICE DEPARTMENT TO AMEND ARTICLE II ENTITLED OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT, SECTION §77-15 ENTITLED E THEREOF, ENTITLED ACCOUNTING OF HOURS; PAYMENT OF HOURS PROVIDING FOR HOURLY FEE FOR PRIVATE EMPLOYMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of the Borough of Emerson as follows;

Section 1. Section 77-15 of the Chapter 77, Police Department, of the Code of Emerson is hereby amended to establish the hourly rate of \$140.00 for calculating escrow fees for the outside employment of a borough police officer:

§ 77-15. Escrow deposit by prospective employer.

- A. Outside employment relating to the employment of Borough police officers for services such as, but not limited to, emergency traffic control, traffic management for site development, special event assignments for charitable or public interest groups shall be permitted upon the deposit by the prospective employer into escrow the sum of \$140.00 times the number of hours the police officer will be utilized at least five business days in advance of the date on which police officers are to be employed by the private employer.
- B. Consideration will be given to any nonprofit organization in the Borough of Emerson requiring police services for its effort to hold community fund-raisers or sponsor community events. The fee per officer per hour will be \$50 plus the Borough administrative fee. The Borough has the option of also charging an administrative fee based on the input of the Chief of Police and the Borough Administrator. The 2018 administrative fee is \$34.31. All officers regardless of rank or seniority will receive the same \$50 per hour rate of compensation.

§77-16 Accounting of hours; payment to officer


The Borough shall be provided with an actual account of hours worked, certified as true by both the private employer and the police officer. The police officer shall be paid from the escrowed funds at the prevailing senior patrolman's hourly overtime rate, which will change yearly and follow the contract signed and authorized between PBA 206 and the Governing Body, *Editor's Note: See Ch. 85, Salaries and Compensation.* and other deductions shall be made as required for such payroll disbursements in addition to such administrative costs as are permitted by law and/or regulation

Section 2. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2019.
