NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was adopted on the second reading after a Public Hearing at the Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson on the 6th day of April, 2021. A copy of Ordinance 1626-21 is on file in the Borough Clerk's Office in the Municipal Building, 1 Municipal Pl., Emerson, NJ 07630.

CAPITAL ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$31,000 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF POLICE BODY CAMERAS IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF EMERSON, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY AND TO TRANSFER AN UNEXPENDED BOND ORDINANCE BALANCE AND REAPPROPRIATE SAME TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey now finds and determines that a \$31,000 funded appropriation balance constituting unexpended bond proceeds of the Borough's 2020 General Improvement Bonds is not necessary for the purposes for which such bonds were issued and that it is in the Borough's best interest to use said moneys for costs of acquiring Police body cameras, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Emerson, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby determined, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, that the funded appropriation balance

constituting unexpended bond proceeds in the following ordinance is no longer needed for the purposes for which the bonds were issued and that it is in the best interest of the Borough to transfer and reappropriate such funded appropriation for a capital purpose in accordance with Section 2 hereof:

Section 2. The Borough is hereby authorized to acquire body cameras for the use of the Police Department in, by and for the Borough. The sum of \$31,000 is hereby appropriated from the funded appropriation balance transferred and reappropriated in accordance with Section 1 hereof to the payment of the cost of the improvement authorized in this Section 2.

Section 3. Said improvement is a lawful capital improvement of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five years. Said improvement shall be made and undertaken as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital

budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
