ORDINANCE NUMBER 1630-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING PART I, CHAPTER 85, “SALARIES AND COMPENSATION,” TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT PROPERTY MAINTENANCE OFFICER, IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:9-165.

Part I, Chapter 85

[Adopted ____-2021 by Ord. No. ____]

Chapter 85, “Salaries and Compensation”

Section 1: The salary for the position of Property Maintenance Officer, herein set forth effective April 20, 2021, and each year thereafter until amended or repealed, is hereby established and fixed as the salary to be paid for the position, wherein a minimum and maximum range is set. The salary shall be paid to the holder of said position within the minimum and maximum range set by Resolution.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE OFFICER	\$9,300	\$17,950

Section 2: A specific salary for the position of Property Maintenance Officer shall be adopted by Resolution of the Borough Council and may be amended.

Section 3: The Borough reserves the right to pay any new employee for the position a salary less than the minimum stated above; provided, however, that upon successful completion of a probationary period, said employee shall be paid a salary at least equal to the minimum stated for the position.

Section 4: The Borough may grant discretionary increments, provided that the employee's salary does not exceed the maximum for the position.

Section 5: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reasons, the remaining portions of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.
