Health Assistant notified the Board of Health members that in case of a fire follow the Fire Exit sign above the door to the left of the Conference Room and exit calmly.

The April 16, 2015 Board of Health meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Board of Health President Elaine Rizzo.

Motion by Nicole Argenzia, Seconded by Cindy Bischoff, that the Board of Health Minutes of February 12, 2014 be approved as written.

The Financial, Vital Statistics, and Dog Licensing reports for February and March were accepted as submitted.

The Health Inspector's report for February and March were accepted as submitted.

All About Me day care center was inspected and received a Conditional rating. The establishment received a Conditional rating upon reinspection, as their insurance was not up-to-date. All About Me facility was inspected a third time and is Satisfactory.

Mara's Italian Market received a Conditional rating because of poor housekeeping.

A Board of Health member noted that employees from Rispoli Pastry Shop are not wearing gloves or using wax paper to handle food. Health Officer Daniel Levy will speak to the owner.

The Health Officer's report for February and March were accepted as submitted.

Daniel Levy reported that the health department received a complaint from a resident regarding sanitary issues at Party Play and Tumble. Health Officer recommended to the manager that the equipment be sanitized properly. Health Officer also suggested that the sink and vanity in the restroom be replaced.

OLD BUSINESS

a. Tattoo Parlor Ordinance - The final draft of the Tattoo Parlor Ordinance is complete. The ordinance will be adopted upon review and approval of the borough attorney. The tattoo artist will be invited to attend a meeting to discuss the rules and regulations.

b. Cloud 9 Vapes – Health Officer Daniel Levy will ask the construction official if Cloud 9 Vapes has a Certificate of Occupancy since the establishment appears to be in business. Police officers explained to the owner that tinted windows are not permitted.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Tanning Salon – Emerson does not have an ordinance regarding tanning salons, as such establishments are State regulated. Health Assistant will poll neighboring towns to inquire if they have a local ordinance.
