**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EMERSON RECREATION COMMISSION WAS HELD ON JUNE 5, 2014 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE RECREATION CENTER.**

In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notification regarding the date, time and location of this meeting was submitted to the Bergen Record and Ridgewood News and posted in Borough Hall.

Presiding Officer Dave Rector notified the Recreation Commission members that in case of a fire follow the Fire Exit signs above the doors and exit calmly.

The meeting of the Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:30 p.m. with a quorum in attendance.

**I Open Session**

Presiding Officer Dave Rector notified the Recreation Commission members that no one will be in attendance for Open Session.

**II Summer Hoops**

Presiding Officer Dave Rector reported that George Mokrzecki expressed interest in helping out with Summer Hoops.

**III Fireworks**

Presiding Officer Dave Rector noted that insurance will be needed for the band naming the Borough of Emerson as additionally insured. The leader of the band owns a business and will supply the insurance through his company.

Fundraising letters were sent out and donations have been received from local businesses and individuals.

The fireworks announcement needs to be approved and distributed to the schools. A press release should be sent to the media soon. Presiding Officer Dave Rector suggests that the Recreation Commission post the event on social media sites, such as Facebook and Twitter. The rain date for the fireworks is Sunday, June 15.

The banners from the sponsors will be put up Thursday night before the fireworks event.

There will be no food vendors except for baseball's concession stand.

Presiding Officer Dave Rector would like video coverage of the fireworks event.

Parking will be at Assumption Academy, B'Nai Israel and Emerson Golf Club. The Police Captain suggested that the Recreation Commission supply parking monitors to guide residents into their parking spot. He also suggested that the Commission count the vehicles in the parking lot to determine if police are needed to direct traffic.
