**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EMERSON BOARD OF HEALTH WAS HELD ON MAY 14, 2015 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE BOROUGH HALL.**

These Minutes have not been formally approved by the Emerson Board of Health and are subject to change or modification at the next regular meeting at which time they will be adopted.

Roll Call: Elaine Rizzo, Nicole Argenzia, Cindy Bischoff, Gabriel Whited and Linda Lahey. Also present was Daniel Levy, Health Officer; K. A. Hodges, Public Health Nurse; Danielle Di Paola, Board of Health liaison and Peggy Di Lello, Health Assistant

Health Assistant notified the Board of Health members that in case of a fire follow the Fire Exit sign above the door to the left of the Conference Room and exit calmly.

The May 14, 2015 Board of Health meeting was called to order at 7:33 p.m. by Board of Health President Elaine Rizzo.

Motion by Nicole Argenzia, Seconded by Cindy Bischoff, that the Board of Health Minutes of April 16, 2015 be approved as written.

The Financial, Vital Statistics, and Dog Licensing reports for April were accepted as submitted.

The Health Inspector's report for April was accepted as submitted.

All businesses inspected for the month of April received a Satisfactory rating.

The Health Officer's report for April was accepted as submitted.

Health Officer Daniel Levy reported that a dog on Maple Lane bit its owner. Since the rabies expiration date was not current, the health officer ordered the dog to be quarantined for ten (10) days at Teterboro Animal Shelter.

The Public Health Nurse's report for April was accepted as submitted.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Tattoo Parlor Ordinance

The Borough Attorney, Borough Administrator and Board of Health members reviewed the draft Tattoo Parlor Ordinance and made revisions.

b. Cloud 9 Vapes

Health Officer Daniel Levy reported that Cloud 9 Vapes was granted a "verbal" Certificate of Occupancy. The establishment is operating without a written C/O, and it is unclear whether the Building Department or Land Use Board issued a "verbal" C/O. It would not be a health issue if the business was only selling E-Cigarettes, and not smoking or vaping. A resident mentioned to the Board of Health that customers are vaping and witnessed smoke encircling the premises. Since Cloud 9 Vapes has now become a health issue, the Borough Administrator, Health Officer and Construction Official will have a meeting in the near future to discuss the matter.

c. Tanning Salon

Tanning salons are State regulated and municipalities could adopt a local ordinance. The Board of Health members will decide if they will do so at a future meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Assumption Church Carnival

Health Officer Daniel Levy noted that Assumption Church will be having a carnival on the premises July 8 through July 12. The two vendors will pay the special event fee of \$100.00 for a temporary permit.

Health Officer Daniel Levy noted that Emerson's Town Picnic will be held on June 20. A special permit will not be required, and the health inspector will be available to inspect the food.

Having no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
