Since January 1st, there have been over 88 reported positive cases of Covid-19 in Emerson, 83 residential and 5 in our long-term care facilities. It appears that numbers may be slowing down but I still continue to urge you to wear a mask, wash your hands, social distance, and if you are feeling sick, stay home in order to protect yourself and others from this virus.

I have received many questions about whether the Borough will be hosting an event in order to administer the vaccine. Due to the limited number of vaccines currently available, there are no plans to do so at this time. However, I am pleased to report that the Borough will be supporting the effort to ensure our seniors are signed up to receive the Covid-19 vaccine. Beginning on Monday, January 25th, senior citizens may call Borough Hall at 201-262-6086 Option 9 to make an appointment with a volunteer who will help you with the registration process.

If you have an email address, when you call Borough Hall, an employee will schedule a time for a volunteer to meet with you in person at the Emerson Public Library to assist you in signing up online for the vaccine. If you do not have an email address, a volunteer will call you with information about how to sign up by phone and if necessary, assist you on that call. Appointments will be held beginning on Wednesday, January 27th from 10:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Appointments will be scheduled so as to maintain proper social distancing at the library; please plan to arrive only if you have an appointment.

If you have already registered for the vaccine, you are in the system and do not need to register again.
