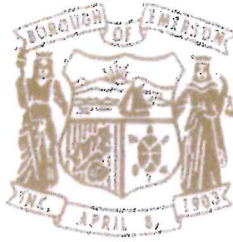

Dear Emerson Residents,

On behalf of the Governing Body, following are some timely updates for the month of April.

Mixed garden debris pickup will resume this Monday, April 3rd and continue each Monday through the end of the year.

The Emerson Volunteer Fire Department's Annual Easter Egg Hunt will take place on Saturday, April 8<sup>th</sup> at noon at Hillman and Benkovic Fields across from the firehouse. The rain date will be Saturday, April 15<sup>th</sup>.

On Monday, April 10th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission will be in the Borough Hall parking lot and will take residents on a first-come, first-serve basis as time allows.

Opening Day Baseball/Softball will take place on Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 9:00 a.m. The parade will begin at the high school and end at Benkovic Field.

Our annual Shredding Day is scheduled for Saturday, April 29th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Borough Hall. Please limit your shredding to four boxes or bags.

The Borough of Emerson, through its Shade Tree Commission, will once again plant a tree in memory of those Emerson residents who have passed away between January of 2022 and the present in conjunction with their Arbor Day Ceremony. This event will take place at 1:00 PM on Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup> at Monument Park opposite Villano School. The names of the departed will be read and family members will have the opportunity to share their thoughts with those gathered.

There are still plots available for the Community Garden and applications are still being accepted by the Environmental Commission.

Stay tuned for Earth Week events being held by the Environmental Commission later this month.
